### **OBJECTIVE 1:** FOREST FIRE PREVENTION

- Defining priority areas for interventions that prevent great forest fires (GIF)
- Improving the forest structure through forest fire prevention works
- Improving biodiversity through forestry measures
- Creating a mosaic landscape of forest and agriculture, with clearances and pastures that support mountain agriculture
- Valuing the forest as a **multi-functional resource** and increase its intrinsic biodiversity
- Contributing to global climate change mitigation



# **OBJECTIVE 2:**SOCIAL AND OCCUPATIONAL INTEGRATION

Professional training will be offered to people at **risk of social exclusion** with the goal of forming four permanent teams
of four forestry workers each with ongoing work all year round

Creation of **16** direct jobs

Each team will have an **instructor** who will be the team leader

**4** jobs

Manager and secretary positions, forestry and environmental education


**2** jobs

Forest pasture as a forest fire prevention measure will be promoted, with a **shepherd** tending to one or more livestock herds



### **OBJECTIVE 3:** COMPETITIVE FOREST MANAGEMENT

The creation of a **forest owners association** will allow the development of joint forest management, such that:

- Logistical and production costs will decrease
- Technical forestry support will be provided and a framework action plan will guarantee the professionalism of the work
- A communal pool of forestry machinery will be created which will contribute to the competitiveness of the forest sector
- Forest management targeted at improving the forest structure will increase the value of the forest as a sustainable resource long term
- The decrease in risk of forest fires will make the area more competitive long term.
- The **sale** of the products under the best conditions is guaranteed
- Paperwork and permits will be simplified
- Subsidies for the project's measures will be searched and applied for



### **OBJECTIVE 4:** THE USE OF FOREST BIOMASS

Support for local public and private facilities to use biomass.

This will create demand for the biomass that will be produced in la Vall's forests and close the biomass circle locally, contributing to:

- Boost socio-economic development
- Decrease in the risk of forest fires
- Forest conservation
- Increase in biodiversity
- Climate change mitigation (reduction in CO<sub>2</sub> emissions)
- Reduced external energy dependency

Biomass is the **renewable energy that generates most employment** per kwh

### **OBJECTIVE 5: ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION**

An environmental education centre will be set up where:

- relevant environmental awareness campaigns will be held
- environmental education activities will be developed in collaboration with the local schools (Solsonès and Bergedà regions)
- there will be space for environmental **exhibitions**
- environmental courses and conferences will be held
- educational interactive itineraries in the natural environment of la Vall de Lord will be created





### **OBJECTIVE 6:** FORESTRY WORKERS TRAINING

Professional forestry workers will be trained, among other programmes, with European certificates (European Chainsaw Certificate – ECC):

- → **ECC1** chainsaw maintenance and crosscutting techniques
- → ECC2 basic tree felling techniques (small trees)
- → ECC3 advanced tree felling techniques (bigger trees)

Once the training has been completed, the forestry workers will join the local work teams.

In the future, educational curricula from forest training centres in other countries are planned to be added to the project. The exchange between teachers and trainees will form the basis to achieving this objective.



### **OBJECTIU 7:** ENCOURAGING RURAL DEVELOPMENT

In addition to the boost the project will give to the forest sector, with the resulting repercussions in all other economic sectors in la Vall, the project aims to include other areas, such as:


**LIVESTOCK GRAZING:** introduction of one or more herds in the forest (cattle, sheep, goats, ...)

**AGRICULTURE:** Creation of clearings, open spaces and clear cutting to facilitate agricultural or pastural use (growing of apples, potatoes, fodder, pastures,...)

COST OF EQUIPMENT FOR ANIMAL FARMING	30.000,00€
VEHICLES (4 pick up trucks and running costs)	133.000,00€
EDUCATION (rent of the space, educational material, furniture)	33.000,00€
MISCELLANEOUS (admin,)	7.000,00 €
